A JOINT MEMORIAL

**REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO DECLARE FEBRUARY 20 AS BUFFALO
SOLDIER DAY AND RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTIONS AND SACRIFICE OF
THE BUFFALO SOLDIERS.**

**WHEREAS, the first buffalo soldiers were named so by
Native Americans because the hair and fierce fighting spirit
of the soldiers personified the spirit of the revered buffalo;
and**

**WHEREAS, the buffalo soldiers comprised four Black
regiments, the 9th U.S. cavalry, 10th U.S. cavalry, 24th U.S.
infantry and 25th U.S. infantry, which were assigned to
protect western settlements and railway and telegraph workers
and to explore and map large sections of the American west;
and**

WHEREAS, the buffalo soldiers of the old west earned

1 twenty-five medals of honor, and although more than one
2 million Black soldiers served as buffalo soldiers during World
3 War II, fifty thousand seeing combat, none received the medal
4 of honor until 1997 when President Clinton presented Vernon J.
5 Baker a medal of honor for his valor, along with six other men
6 who received the medal posthumously;

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
8 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 20 be declared "buffalo
9 soldier day" in honor of Black soldiers who served throughout
10 the history of the United States; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
12 transmitted to the New Mexico veterans' service commission.
