facility opened in 1997; and**

immediately adjacent to the Santa Teresa port of entry will be
a key factor in determining whether the state can reap the
full benefits of industrial and residential development
resulting from that increased international trade; and**

14 development of the Santa Teresa port of entry region; and

18 Sunland Park; and the board of commissioners of Dona Ana
