A JOINT MEMORIAL

SUGGESTING THE STATE RECORDS CENTER AND ARCHIVES AND THE STATE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC RECORDS CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING A UNIFORM COMPREHENSIVE ELECTRONIC DATABASE CONTAINING AGENCY RULES AND OTHER STATE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION.

WHEREAS, New Mexico does not have a single electronic repository containing rules and regulations, notices of rulemaking, executive orders and appointments, proclamations and other governmental policy determinations and information that New Mexico residents have access to in order to research issues of concern; and

WHEREAS, it would benefit all citizens, businesses and regional and local governmental entities of the state if a single assessible and complete body of current governmental

1 policy determinations and rulemaking activity existed and
2 could be electronically accessed;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE
4 OF NEW MEXICO that representatives from the state records center
5 and archives and the state commission of public records be
6 requested to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of
7 creating such a repository, including cost, time frame and other
8 related factors; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state records center and
10 archives and the state commission of public records complete
11 and present the study to the appropriate interim legislative
12 committee no later than October 1, 1998; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
14 sent to the administrator of the state records center and
15 archives and to the members of the state commission of public
16 records.
