ASSESS THE COST AND FISCAL PARAMETERS OF YEAR-ROUND SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, about four schools now are open that provide
parents and students the choice of year-round education; and

WHEREAS, some school districts are overcrowded and may
decide to maintain year-round education as a means of coping
with growing enrollments; and

WHEREAS, some school districts may offer year-round
education to provide parents and students more educational
alternatives; and

WHEREAS, in some districts it is a fiscal necessity and
in other districts it is an amenity for parents and students;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE

8 study committee and the state department of public education
9 report their findings and recommendations to the legislature
10 by December 1, 1998; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
12 transmitted to the legislative education study committee and
13 the superintendent of public instruction.
