A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING CONTINUED COOPERATION BETWEEN THE ALBUQUERQUE METROPOLITAN ARROYO FLOOD CONTROL AUTHORITY, THE MIDDLE RIO GRANDE CONSERVANCY DISTRICT AND OTHER ENTITIES IN PROVIDING EFFICIENT AND COST-EFFECTIVE FLOOD PROTECTION TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE GREATER ALBUQUERQUE AREA.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature recognizes that the Albuquerque metropolitan arroyo flood control authority, the middle Rio Grande conservancy district and other entities have a responsibility to provide flood protection to the residents of Albuquerque; and

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque metropolitan arroyo flood control authority and other entities have constructed, own and operate flood control facilities throughout the greater Albuquerque area, including the Rio Grande valley; and
