WHEREAS, given the role this cemetery has played in the lives of so many veterans, it should be officially designated as a national cemetery;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico veterans' service
commission investigate the proper procedures and pursue the
designation of the merchant marine and military memorial
cemetery at Ft. Stanton as a national cemetery and alternate
resting place for New Mexico veterans; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the New Mexico veterans' service commission and members of New Mexico's congressional delegation.
