11	DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE REGARDING		
12	IMPLEMENTATION OF RETAIL ELECTRIC COMPETITION.

14	WHEREAS, the legislature has been studying retail		
15	electric competition since 1993 to determine if its		
16	implementation in New Mexico is in the public interest; and		
17	WHEREAS, in 1996 the legislature unanimously adopted		
18	Senate Joint Memorial 42, which declared that retail electric		
19	competition was not at that time in the public interest of the		
20	state, but directed the New Mexico public utility commission		
21	to study and monitor developments nationally and report back		
22	to the legislature during the 1997 session; and		
23	WHEREAS, the commission issued a report for the 1998		
24	session that it believes that implementation of retail		
25	electric competition is now in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of retail electric competition requires the addressing of numerous interrelated and complex issues that cannot be adequately resolved; and

WHEREAS, the commission is without the requisite statutory authority to mandate retail electric competition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it be the declared intent of the legislature to address retail electric competition through legislation in the 1999 legislative session in a manner that is consistent with the principles articulated in Senate Joint Memorial 42, passed in 1996, with an effective date for customer choice no earlier than January 1, 2001; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature determine whether retail electric competition should begin before the operation of New Mexico transmission systems is transferred to an independent system operator approved by the federal energy regulatory commission and the system is operational; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that neither the New Mexico public utility commission nor its successor agency as of January 1, 1999, the public regulation commission, take any steps in furtherance of requiring retail electric competition until the legislature provides the necessary statutory authority; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the New Mexico legislative council, the New Mexico public utility commission and the public regulation
