WHEREAS, despite scientific advances and the expansion and enhancement in recent decades of health care alternatives and improvements in care delivery, most insurers still choose not to cover some treatments requested by patients or

prescribed by their primary care physicians;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative health and human services committee be requested to prepare legislation to reestablish control by patients of their health care by providing for patient choice and integrative medicine that makes conventional and unconventional medical care and health maintenance equally available to all New Mexico citizens regardless of type of insurance coverage or lack of insurance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative health and human services committee submit its legislative recommendations to the first session of the forty-fourth legislature; and
