A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO CREATE AN INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE TO STUDY AND MAKE LEGISLATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS ON ALTERNATE FORMS OF REGULATION AND TELECOMMUNICATION DEREGULATION AS THEY AFFECT NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, technology of telecommunications is changing at a speed nearly beyond man's comprehension; and

WHEREAS, in attempts to give the industry room to grow in step with these changes, congress enacted the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996; and

WHEREAS, at the state level it is also necessary to allow and promote competition among industry participants; and

WHEREAS, the legislature needs to gather substantial information and to study this very complex issue of telecommunications deregulation, including alternate forms of

regulation, statewide extended areas of service and ways to increase the number of New Mexico households with telephone service:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to create a joint legislative telecommunications deregulation interim committee to study all aspects of the impact of changes and deregulation in the telecommunications industry and alternative forms of regulation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the telecommunications deregulation interim committee invite appropriate testimony from all affected state agencies, including the state corporation commission, the New Mexico public utility commission, the general services department, the economic development department and all interested industry and consumer representatives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the telecommunications deregulation interim committee report its findings and any legislative recommendations to the first session of the forty-fourth legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to the co-chairmen of the New Mexico legislative council.
