WHEREAS, bills giving citizens of New Mexico the freedom to deci de what to do about drive- up window liquor sal es have been and conti nue to be hel d hostage by a small band of I egi sl at ors si nce 1993; and

WHEREAS, such hostage- hol ding has deprived the citizens of New Mexi co of their right to deci de thei $r$ own fates; and

WHEREAS, such hostage-hol ding may have resulted in the otherwi se avoi dable deaths of men, women and children at the hands of drunk drivers who bought their liquor at drive-up wi ndows; and

WHEREAS, Terry Anderson was al so hel d hostage and captive
by a small band of powerful men; and
WHEREAS, Terry Anderson, although beaten and tortured, never abandoned hope that he would be rel eased from captivity;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO that any bill gi ving citizens the freedom to choose whet her their local commities will disallow liquor to be sol d from drive- up wi ndows be hencef orth ni cknamed "Terry Anderson" bills; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to Terry Anderson and that copies of this memorial be transmitted to all nembers of the legi slat ure each session until a local option el ection drive-up window liquor bill is finally passed.
