A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE STATE BOARD EDUCATION TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR EXPANDING THE CHARTER SCHOOLS ACT.

WHEREAS, the Charter Schools Act has allowed a limited number of individual public schools in New Mexico to become charter schools and initiate innovative changes in teaching methods and budgeting; and

WHEREAS, the flexibility allowed by the Charter Schools

Act is available to only a few schools due to limits in the

current law; and

WHEREAS, there are many schools and local school districts which could utilize the flexibility allowed by the Charter School Act to modify the organization and operation of their schools to meet the unique needs of their student population and respond to the challenges and opportunities

presented by the communities they serve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state board of education be requested to make recommendations to the legislative education study committee on ways in which the Charter Schools Act can be amended to address the needs and concerns of individual schools and local school districts that want to acquire charter status; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the state board of education and the director of the legislative education study committee.
