WHEREAS, the culture and history of New Mexico draw many thousands of visitors each year into the state and into the northern New Mexico region who compete with the business

population on a limited network of interstate highways and state and county roads, thereby creating a significant amount of stress on that transportation system; and

WHEREAS, a viable resolution to this dangerous and escalating highway overcrowding may be the development of a regional airport to serve northern New Mexico's businesses, residents and tourists and to attract potential businesses; and

WHEREAS, a regional airport site should be carefully chosen based on a variety of criteria, including the ecosystem of each prospective area, the proximity of each area to municipalities, the geographical feasibility of each prospective site and many other factors, while maintaining and enhancing the quality of life for local residents and augmenting New Mexico's overall transportation infrastructure, which will lead to a stronger, more diverse regional economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that governmental entities in northern New Mexico, including Los Alamos national laboratory, conduct a study to determine the feasibility of building a regional airport in northern New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study be coordinated by Los Alamos national laboratory personnel in cooperation with the university of New Mexico, public and private economic development groups and interested citizens; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the findings be presented to the appropriate interim legislative committee no later than October 1, 1998; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to the director of Los Alamos national laboratory, the board of regents of the university of New Mexico, the governing bodies of Espanola, Los Alamos, Taos and Las Vegas and the board of county commissioners where each municipality is located.
