A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY COUNSELING PROGRAMS ON THE MIDDLE, JUNIOR AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS.

WHEREAS, school children are being subjected to social stresses, including family fragmentation, substance abuse, child abuse, poverty and violence; and

WHEREAS, children may exhibit barriers to learning, such as emotional disorders, underachievement, disruptive behavior, juvenile delinquency and withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, school dropouts, gang members, pregnant teens and substance-abusing youth pose significant social problems; and

WHEREAS, counseling provided by public schools can reduce drug abuse, dropout rates, teen suicide, unemployment and .121764.1

incarceration; and

WHEREAS, school counseling addresses the barriers to learning and contributes to students' success by positively affecting the school environment, student self-discipline, attendance and academic achievement; and

WHEREAS, state policy to reduce social problems and crime can be served by enhancing the availability and quality of public school counseling programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative education study committee be requested to study school counseling programs at the middle, junior and high school levels to augment the committee's 1994 study of elementary school counseling programs and that it include information on national counselor-student ratios; national and state standards for counseling programs and staff; and community, parent and student expectations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative education study committee review the impact of the school funding formula on K-12 counseling programs in each school district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative education study committee report its findings and recommendations to the legislature by December 1, 1998; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be . 121764.1

transmitted to the director of the legislative education study committee and to the superintendents of each school district.
