REQUESTING STATE AGENCIES NOT TO USE VOICE MAIL AND REQUESTING
THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO ASSESS THE EFFICACY OF
VOICE MAIL AND TO REPORT ITS FINDINGS TO THE NEW MEXICO
LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, citizens of the state and persons regulated by state agencies are required to comply with rules by law and must obtain information, forms and documents from state agencies in order to comply with laws; and

WHEREAS, person-to-person contact is frequently necessary in order to communicate with government representatives but, too often, citizens and elected officials get lost in the maze of voice message machinery; and

WHEREAS, the result of lack of communication with citizens is noncompliance, confusion, frustration and anger

toward the government and, therefore, the democratic process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that all state agencies be requested to be conscientious in responding to citizen and legislative inquiries and to avoid excessive use of voice message machinery except for after official hours and when requested by the caller to be given access to voice message devices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general services department assess the extent of use by state agencies of voice message machines and the efficacy of such use and to report its findings and recommendations to the New Mexico legislative council by November 1, 1998; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the heads of each executive, legislative and judicial agency, to the general services department and to the New Mexico legislative council.
