21	performs single-agency, comprehensive public safety functions,
22	as there are a number of public safety functions that reside
23	in other agencies; for example, the state fire marshal and the
24	firefighter's academy are in the state corporation commission;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE 5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative council assign the 6 7 appropriate legislative interim committee to take testimony on the mission of the department of public safety vis-a-vis other 8 9 state agencies responsible for public safety issues; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the testimony include an 11 analysis and evaluation of a variety of issues, including: 12 A. the status of the state crime laboratory; 13 B. the effectiveness of satellite law enforcement 14 training academies located throughout the state; C. the moribund state of the governor's organized 15 16 crime prevention commission; and the feasibility of permitting small communities 17 D. 18 to contract with the department of public safety for law 19 enforcement services; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the legislative council, the governor and the 21 22 secretary of public safety. - 2 -23 24 25 . 120764. 1
