WHEREAS, a divided four-lane highway will cut down dramatically on the number of deaths, injuries and collisions occurring on this stretch of road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state highway and transportation department be requested to study the feasibility of and need for widening United States highway 666 between Yah-Ta-Hey and Shiprock to four lanes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of highway and transportation.
