WHEREAS, Wilma is survived by a loving family, including her husband Dan, sons Danny and Phillip, brother Jim, sisters Mary, Maxine and Jennie and her four grandchildren to whom she was devoted; and

WHEREAS, she is remembered fondly by legislators, staff, lobbyists and the many other friends she had in Santa Fe;
