14 WHEREAS, Section 16-2-11 NMSA 1978 gives the power to
15 acquire land for state park or state recreational purposes;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 requires ratification
18 and approval of any sale, trade or lease of real property for
19 a consideration of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or
20 more; and

21 WHEREAS, the state parks division of the energy, minerals
22 and natural resources department is desirous of receiving by
23 trade approximately forty acres of real property currently
24 owned by a private trust adjacent to Bluewater Lake state park
25 that has recreational value and will mitigate current access

3 value to the state; and

4 WHEREAS, the state parks division wishes to trade a
5 parcel of state land described as:

6 "NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 13 North,
7 Range 13 West N. M. P. M "; and

8 WHEREAS, the state parks division wishes to acquire a
9 parcel of private land described as:

10 "NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 12 North,
11 Range 12 West N. M. P. M "; and

12 WHEREAS, the properties shall be appraised using
13 generally accepted appraisal techniques for this type of
14 property to establish fair market value and the state parks
15 division may relinquish title to the described state property
16 of an equivalent value at no cost to the state;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
18 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the proposed trade be ratified and
19 approved pursuant to the provisions of Section 13-6-3 NMSA
20 1978; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be
22 transmitted to the state parks division of the energy,
23 minerals and natural resources department.
