AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO TRAIN OR HIRE EMERGENCY MEDICAL
TECHNICIANS FOR THE JEMEZ VALLEY IN SANDOVAL COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --One hundred thousand dollars
(\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for
the purpose of hiring and, if necessary, training two
additional licensed emergency medical technicians to be
stationed at the pueblo of Jemez to respond to emergency
medical needs of Jemez valley residents. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000
shall revert to the general fund.
