Section 1. Section 7-4-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 153, Section 1) is repealed and a new Section 7-4-10 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"7-4-10. [NEW MATERIAL] APPORTIONMENT OF BUSINESS INCOME. -- All business income shall be apportioned to this state by multiplying the income by a fraction, the numerator of which is the property factor plus the payroll factor plus the sales factor and the denominator of which is three."
