AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR  
AT-RISK TEENAGE PARENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the vocational education division of the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of providing high school education programs for at-risk teenage parents statewide. The appropriation shall be used to provide classes in basic parenting, nutrition, hygiene skills and child care for teenage parents. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STATEWIDE EDUCATIONAL RECOVERY  
PROGRAM FOR TEEN PARENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure by the vocational education division in fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of providing self-sustaining high school education programs that include training in prenatal care, parenting, healthy relationships, problem solving and economic independence for teenage parents as well as professional development, resources and technical assistance for teachers addressing both intervention and prevention of teenage pregnancy. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.
