RELATI NG TO EDUCATI ON; ALLOW NG ALTERNATI VE SCHOOLS TO BE ELI Gl BLE FOR SI ZE ADJ USTMENT PROGRAM UNI TS; MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 22-8-23 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1975, Chapter 119, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
" 22-8-23. SI ZE ADJ USTMENT PROGRAM UNI TS. --
A. An approved publ ic school with a MEM of less than [400] four hundred, including early chil dhood education full-time-equi val ent MEM but excl uding membershi p in cl ass C and cl ass D prograns and excl uding full-time-equi val ent menber shi p in three- and four-year-ol d devel opment ally di sabled prograns, is el igible for additional programunits. Separate school s established to provi de special programs,
i ncl uding [but not linited to] vocational [ and alternative] education, shall not be classified as public schools for purposes of generating size adjustment programunits.

Al ternative schools approved by the department shall be el igible for size adjustment programunits. The number of additional programunits to whi ch a school district is entitled under this subsection is the sum of elemtary-juni or hi gh units and seni or high units computed in the following manner:

El ement ary-J uni or Hi gh Units
200 - MEM x $1.0 \times \mathrm{MEM}=$ Units 200
where MEM is equal to the menbership of an approved el ement ary or juni or hi gh school, incl uding early chil dhood education full-time-equi val ent membershi p but excl uding member shi p in cl ass C and class D prograns and excluding full-timeequi val ent menbershi p in three- and four-year-old devel opmentally di sabled prograns;

Seni or Hi gh Units
200 - MEM $\times 2.0 \times \mathrm{MEM}=$ Units 200
or,

> Seni or Hi gh Units $\frac{400-\text { MEM }}{400} \times 1.6 \times$ MEM $=$ Units
whi chever cal cul ation for seni or high units is hi gher, where MEM is equal to the membershi p of an approved seni or high school excl uding membership in cl ass C and cl ass D prograns.
B. A school di strict with total MEM of less than [4,000] four thousand, including early chil dhood education full-time- equi val ent MEM is eligible for additional program units. The number of additional programunits to which a di strict is entitled under this subsection is the number of di strict units computed in the following manner:

District Units
$\underline{4,000-M E M} \times 0.15 \times \mathrm{MEM}=$ Units
4, 000
where MEMis equal to the total district menbership, i ncl uding early chil dhood educati on full-time- equi val ent rember shi p.
C. A school district with over [ 10,000 ] ten thousand MEM with a ratio of MEM to seni or hi gh schools less than [4,000: 1] four thousand to one is el igible for additional program units based on the number of approved regul ar seni or high schools that are not el igible for seni or high units under Subsection $A$ of $t$ hi $s$ section. The number of additional program units to which an eligi ble school district is entitled under $t$ his subsection is the number of units computed in the following manner:

where MEM is equal to the total district membership, including early chil dhood education full-time-equi val ent menber shi p, and where seni or hi gh school s are equal to the number of approved regul ar seni or high school s in the di strict."

Section 2. APPROPRI ATI ON. -- Fi ve milli on three hundred thousand dollars $(\$ 5,300,000)$ is appropriated fromthe general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 to fund additional program units gener ated by alternative schools size adj ust ment program units. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remai ni ng at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund. - 4 -
