AN ACT

ALLOWING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO KEEP THEIR SCHOOLS OPEN LONGER TO  
OFFER CLASSES IN THE EVENING HOURS AND ON WEEKENDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-2-8.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986,  
Chapter 33, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-2-8.1. LENGTH OF SCHOOL DAY--MINIMUM --

A. Regular students shall be in school-directed  
programs, exclusive of lunch, for a minimum of the following:

(1) kindergarten, two and one-half hours per  
day or four hundred fifty hours per year;

(2) grades one through six, five and one-half  
hours per day or nine hundred ninety hours per year; and

(3) grades seven through twelve, six hours  
per day or one thousand eighty hours per year.
