19	Persons seventy years of age or older and persons who have
20	served as members of a petit jury panel or a grand jury in
21	either state or federal courts within the preceding thirty-six
22	months shall be exempt from sitting or serving as jurors in
23	any of the courts of this state when they, at their option,
24	request to be excused from service by reason of the
25	[exemption] <u>exemptions</u> granted by this section. <u>A person</u>
