11 RELATING TO VETERANS; CHANGING PROVISIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF
12 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES TO DISABLED VETERANS; PROVIDING
13 FOR FREE STATE PARK PASSES TO DISABLED VETERANS.
14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. Section 66-3-412 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1979,
17 Chapter 299, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "66-3-412. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES--ONE HUNDRED
19 PERCENT DISABLED VETERANS--SUBMISSION OF PROOF--PENALTY.--

20 A. The [~~division~~] department shall issue
21 distinctive registration plates for up to two vehicles to
22 [~~any~~] a person who is a veteran of the armed forces of the
23 United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NMSA 1978, and
24 was one hundred percent disabled while serving in the armed
25 forces of the United States, upon the submission by the person

1 of proof satisfactory to the [~~division~~] department that he was
2 one hundred percent disabled while serving in the armed forces
3 of the United States. No fee, including the regular
4 registration fee applicable to the passenger motor vehicle, if
5 any, shall be collected for issuance of a special registration
6 plate pursuant to this section. [~~Any~~] A person eligible for a
7 special registration plate pursuant to this section and also
8 eligible for one or more special registration plates pursuant
9 to Sections 66-3-406, 66-3-409 and 66-3-411 NMSA 1978 shall be
10 issued only one special registration plate of his choice.

11 B. No person shall falsely represent himself to
12 have been one hundred percent disabled while serving in the
13 armed forces of the United States so as to be eligible to be
14 issued special registration plates pursuant to this section
15 when he in fact was not one hundred percent disabled while
16 serving in the armed forces of the United States.

17 C. [~~Any~~] A person eligible for a special
18 registration plate under this section shall only be eligible
19 for one such plate.

20 D. [~~Any~~] A person who violates the provisions of
21 Subsection B of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor. "

22 Section 2. [NEW MATERIAL] FREE STATE PARK PASSES TO
23 DISABLED VETERANS. --The state parks division of the energy,
24 minerals and natural resources department shall provide up to
25 three free passes for entry into and use of state parks to a

2 Proof of disability satisfactory to the division is required
3 to obtain the free passes.

4 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. --The effective date of the
5 provisions of this act is July 1, 1999.
