"17-2-10. VIOLATION OF GAME AND FISH LAWS OR REGULATIONS--PENALTIES.--

A. Any person violating any of the provisions of Chapter 17 NMSA 1978 or any regulations adopted by the state game commission that relate to the time, extent, means or manner that game animals, birds or fish may be hunted, taken, captured, killed, possessed, sold, purchased or shipped is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed six months.
