- the posted speed limit in construction **(4)** zones; provided that the posted speed limit shall be determined by an engineering study performed by the state highway and transportation department.
- In every event, speed shall be so controlled by В. the driver as may be necessary:
- to avoid colliding with any person, (1) vehicle or other conveyance on or entering the highway;
- to comply with legal requirements as may be established by the state highway and transportation department or the New Mexico state police division of the department of public safety and the duty of all persons to use due care: and
- **(3)** to protect workers in a construction zone.
- C. The speed limits set forth in Subsection A of this section may be altered as authorized in Section 66-7-303 NMSA 1978."
- EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the Section 2. provisions of this act is July 1, 1999.
