FOR THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE

RELATING TO THE TERMINATION OF AGENCY LIFE; EXTENDING THE LIFE OF CERTAIN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 28-1-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987, Chapter 333, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"28-1-15. TERMINATION OF AGENCY LIFE--DELAYED REPEAL. --The human rights commission is terminated on July 1, [1999] 2005 pursuant to the provisions of the Sunset Act. commission shall continue to operate according to the provisions of Chapter 28, Article 1 NMSA 1978 until July 1, $[\frac{2000}{2006}]$ Effective July 1, [2000] 2006, Chapter 28, Article 1 NMSA 1978 is repealed."

Section 2. Section 50-1-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987, Chapter 333, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

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"50-1-9. TERMINATION OF AGENCY LIFE--DELAYED REPEAL. --The labor and industrial commission and the office of the director of the labor and industrial division of the [department of] labor department are terminated on July 1, [1999] 2005 pursuant to the provisions of the Sunset Act. commission and the director shall continue to operate according to the provisions of Chapter 50, Article 1 NMSA 1978 until July 1, [2000] 2006. The board shall continue to operate according to the provisions of Chapter 10, Article 7D NMSA 1978 until July 1, 2006. Effective July 1, 2006, Chapter 10, Article 7D NMSA 1978 is repealed."
