1 are selected and the value in excess of security interests plus that of other exempt property is less than fifteen 2 thousand dollars (\$15,000) or if there is not fifteen thousand 3 dollars (\$15,000) worth of exempt property in the estate, the 4 spouse or children are entitled to other assets of the estate, 5 6 if any, to the extent necessary to make up the fifteen 7 thousand dollar (\$15,000) value. Rights to specific property for the family allowance and assets needed to make up a 8 9 deficiency in the property have priority over all claims 10 against the estate, but the right to any assets to make up a deficiency of exempt property abates as necessary to permit 11 12 earlier payment of the family allowance. These rights are in 13 addition to any benefit or share passing to the surviving spouse or children by intestate succession or by the 14 15 decedent's will, unless otherwise provided by the decedent in the will or other governing instrument." 16
