AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS; PROVIDING FOR A MEDIATION PROGRAM BY  
PROBATE JUDGES IN MAGISTRATE COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. MAGISTRATE COURTS--AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT A  
MEDIATION PROGRAM-TRAINING. --

A. If approved by the administrative office of the  
courts pursuant to Subsection B of this section, a probate  
judge shall have authority to conduct mediation programs in a  
magistrate court.

B. The director of the administrative office of  
the courts may approve a probate judge to exercise the  
authority conferred in Subsection A of this section if the  
judicial district for the county in which the magistrate court  
is located has certified that the probate judge is qualified,
