## AN ACT

RELATI NG TO MOTOR VEHI CLES; PROVI DI NG FOR I NCREASED PENALTY ASSESSMENTS FOR SPEEDI NG BY COMMERCI AL MDTOR VEH CLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:
"66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT M SDEMEANORS- DEFI NI TI ON- SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS. --
A. Except as provi ded in Subsection D of this section, as used in the Mbtor Vehicle Code, "penalty assessment misdemeanor" means viol ation of any of the following listed sections of the NMSA 1978 for whi ch the I isted penalty assessment is established:

B. The term"penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include any viol ation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to any person.
C. Wen an alleged viol at or of a penalty assessment misdemeanor el ects to accept a notice to appear in Iieu of a notice of penalty assessment, no fine imposed upon I ater conviction shall exceed the penalty assessment established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and no probation i mosed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall exceed ni nety days.
D. As used in the Mbtor Vehicle Code, "penal ty assessment misdemeanor" includes a vi ol ation of Section 66-7301 NMSA 1978 by a commercial motor vehicle for which the foll owing penal ty assessment is establ i shed:

## (1) for speedi ng up to and incl udi ng ten

miles an hour over the speed limit, a penalty assessment of five hundred dollars (\$500);
(2) for speedi ng from el even up to and incl uding fifteen miles an hour over the speed limit, a penal ty assessment of six hundred dollars (\$600);
(3) for speedi ng fromsixteen up to and incl uding twenty miles an hour over the speed Iimit, a penalty assessment of seven hundred dollars (\$700);
(4) for speeding from twenty-one up to and incl udi ng twenty-five miles an hour over the speed Iimit, a penalty assessment of ei ght hundred dollars (\$800);
(5) for speedi ng from twenty-si $x$ up to and incl uding thirty miles an hour over the speed limit, a penalty assessment of ni ne hundred dollars (\$900);
(6) for speeding fromthirty-one up to and including thirty-five miles an hour over the speed Iimit, a penal ty assessment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000); and
(7) for speeding more than thirty-five miles an hour over the speed limit, a penalty assessment of one thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 1,500)$."
