15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. A new section of the New Mexico Works Act is
17	enacted to read:
18	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] UNDERPRIVILEGED FAMILY OUTREACH CENTER
19	A. A benefit group may be referred to the southern
20	New Mexico family outreach center by the department for either
21	an intensive twelve week residential or day training and
22	rehabilitation program.
23	B. The department shall suspend regular payments
24	of cash assistance and food stamps to the benefit group for
25	the twelve weeks that they reside, if referred to the

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residential rehabilitation program, at the southern New Mexico family outreach center. The department shall pay the underprivileged family outreach center each month from the cash assistance and food stamps that the benefit group would receive if they were not enrolled at the southern New Mexico family outreach center.

C. The department in cooperation with the children, youth and families department shall provide necessary child-care services to any benefit group enrolled at the southern New Mexico family outreach center.

D. The department in cooperation with the public transportation programs bureau of the state highway and transportation department shall provide transportation to those benefit groups that enroll in the southern New Mexico family outreach center from any part of the state.

E. The department shall coordinate with the southern New Mexico family outreach center to ensure that funding received pursuant to the federal act is spent appropriately and that all the necessary record keeping and accounting is maintained."

Section 2. Section 9-7-10.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, Chapter 156, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"9-7-10.1. REHABILITATION CENTERS. --

<u>A.</u> There are created within the department [ <del>of</del> <del>health</del>] the "northern New Mexico rehabilitation center" and .126531.3 - 2 -

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1 the "southern New Mexico rehabilitation center] family 2 outreach center".

The [centers] northern New Mexico 3 B. rehabilitation center shall be at Las Vegas [and Roswell, 4 respectively] and shall provide the citizens of New Mexico 5 with physical therapy, speech and hearing diagnoses and 6 7 therapy and family counseling services in conjunction with 8 such therapy and in cooperation with related programs of other 9 governmental and nonprofit entities. Such therapy and service 10 shall be provided without regard to eligibility for federally 11 funded vocational rehabilitation services.

C. The southern New Mexico family outreach center shall provide to participants as defined in the New Mexico Works Act the following services in a residential or day patient setting:

(1) nonmedical substance abuse treatment;

(2) pre-pregnancy planning; and

(3) domestic violence counseling treatment.

D. The southern New Mexico family outreach center shall provide to participants job training, job readiness, parenting classes, money management classes and life skills training to assist in their transition into paid employment and self-sufficiency.

14	thousand dollars (\$5,400,000) is appropriated from the					
15	temporary assistance for needy families block grant to the					
16	southern New Mexico family outreach center for expenditure in					
17	fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of providing services to New					
18	Mexico Works participants that will assist them in obtaining					
19	gainful employment. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance					
20	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the					
21	temporary assistance for needy families block grant.					
22	Section 4. APPROPRIATIONOne million six hundred					
23	seventy-one thousand dollars (\$1,671,000) is appropriated from					
24	the general fund to the southern New Mexico family outreach					
25	center for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of					

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	1	providing medical rehabilitative services to residents of New
	2	Mexico. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
	3	the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.
	4	Section 5. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public

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
