(2) any commercial enterprise in storing, warehousing, distributing or selling products of agriculture, mining or industry but does not include facilities designed for the sale of goods or commodities at retail or [distribution to the public of electricity, gas, water or telephone or other services commonly classified as public utilities] facilities regulated by the public regulation commission;

(3) any business in which all or part of the activities of such business involve the supplying of services to the general public or to governmental agencies or to a specific industry or customer but does not include


