AN ACT
RELATI NG TO AGRI CULTURE; ANENDI NG AND ENACTI NG SECTI ONS OF THE COTTON BOLL WEEVI L CONTROL ACT; PROVI DI NG FOR TERM NATI ON OF COTTON BOLL WEEVI L CONTROL COMM TTEES; PROVI DI NG ADDI TI ONAL PONERS; EXEMPTI NG COMM TTEES FROM THE PROCUREMENT CODE AND THE PERSONNEL ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 76-6A-10 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1996, Chapter 77, Section 10) is amended to read:
" 76-6A- 10. REFERENDUM - COTTON BOLL WEEVI L CONTROL DI STRI CTS- - [ LOGAL] COTTON BOLL WEEVI L CONTROL COMM TTEES. -After public hearing, if the director deci des there is justification for creating a cotton boll weevil control di strict, the department shall hol d a referendum Wen cotton producers who represent sixty-six percent of the cotton . 127608. 1
acreage within the area threatened with or infested by the cotton boll weevil vote in favor of the establishment of a cotton boll weevil control di strict, [ such] a cotton boll weevil control district shall be created. The cotton producers within a cotton boll weevil control district shall promptly establish, and shall el ect not less than three nor more than seven members to, a [ focal] cotton boll weevil control committee. [ The] Cotton boll weevil control committee nembers shall not recei ve per di em or compensation for thei $r$ services. Cotton boll weevil control districts and [ Hocat] cotton boll weevil control committees shall cease to exi st [six months after the successful eradication of theagricultural cotton boll weevil, as deternined by thedirector, or at the end of five years from the date of their ereation, whichever is sooner. A petition to continue the eotton boll weevil control district may be made to the director six months prior to the scheduled date for termination of the cotton boll weevil control di-strict. After a public hearing on the petition, the director may extend theternination date of any cotton boll weevil control district for a period not to exceed three years wi thout a referendum] when the cotton boll weevil control committee and the director determine that all financial and legal obl igations have been satisfied. "

Section 2. Section 76-6A-11 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1996, 127608. 1

Chapter 77, Section 11, as amended) is amended to read:
" $76-6 \mathrm{~A}-11$. COTTON BOLL WEEVI L CONTROL COMM TTEES- ADDI TI ONAL DUTI ES AND POWERS. - -
A. Cotton boll weevil control committees may:
(1) conduct prograns to suppress or eradi cate cotton boll weevils within their cotton boll weevil control di stricts;
(2) cooperate in the administration of the Cotton Boll Weevil Control Act through the use of state or federal personnel and facilities or both;
(3) contract for services or enter into cooper ati ve agreements;
(4) publ ish information and conduct seminars on the distribution and control of the cotton boll weevil; [ and]
(5) I evy and collect a special assessment, based on cotton acreage or cotton yi el d per acre within the cotton boll weevil control districts; and
(6) borrow money or accept grants, donations or contributions for any pur pose consistent with the powers and duties of the cotton boll weevil control committee.
B. Cotton boll weevil control committees shall provi de a compl ete accounting of the funds collected through the special assessment to all partici pating cotton producers in the cotton boll weevil control districts.

C. The cotton boll weevil control committee shall send notice of the establishment of a cotton boll weevil control district and its defined boundaries to the organic commdity commission within fourteen days of its est abl i shment.
D. If the cotton boll weevil control district incl udes certified organi $c$ acreage, the cotton boll weevil control committee shall sel ect an organic farmer operating within the district, who shall have all the powers of a committee menber, to serve on the cotton boll weevil control committee. "

Section 3. A new section of the Cotton Boll Weevil Control Act is enacted to read:
"[ NEW MATERI AL] EXEMPTI ON FROM PROCUREMENT CODE AND PERSONNEL ACT.--Cotton boll weevil control committees are exempt fromthe provisions of the Procurement Code and the Personnel Act. The committee members and committee empl oyees are public empl oyees for the purposes of the Tort Cl ains Act and shall be provi ded all insurance and self-insurance coverage provided by the risk management di vision of the general services department."
