## AN ACT

RELATI NG TO AREA VOCATI ONAL SCHOOLS; REQUI RI NG SI NGLE- MEMBER ELECTI ON DI STRI CTS FOR AREA VOCATI ONAL SCHOOL BOARD ELECTI ONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 21-17-4 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1967, Chapter 177, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:
"21-17-4. DESI GNATI ON AS AN AREA VOCATI ONAL SCHOOL BY THE STATE BOARD - BOARD ELECTI ONS- - SI NGLE-MEMBER DI STRI CTS . - -
A. Upon recei pt and exami nation of the pl an and supporting evi dence, the state board shall conduct hearings, i nvesti gate records and procure such ot her inf or mation rel ating to vocational training as it deems necessary and appropriate.
B. If the state board finds that the pl an provides an adequate, broad vocational and techni cal educational . 127470. 1
program serves sufficient students for an economical operation, provi des for adequate financing and sensi bly rel ates to a statewi de pattern for devel opment of vocational and techni cal education, the state board may approve the plan.
C. After approval by the state board of the pl an, the area vocational hi gh school shall be officially desi gnated by the state board as an area vocational school, shall be oper ated in accordance with provisions in the state plan for vocational education and shall meet all ot her requirements of an accredited school.

## D. [ At the first area vocational school board

 election, menbers of the board elected to positions 1, 3 and 5shall be elected for terns ending February 28, 1989 and mentbers elected to positions 2 and 4 shall be elected for terns ending-February 28, 1991. Thereafter, each board menber shall be elected for a term of four years. The-] Board el ections shall be conducted pursuant to the provisions of the El ection Code and shall be hel din the same manner and at the same time as regular school district el ections on the first Tuesday in February of each odd-numbered year [ beginning with the election to be held in February of 1987]. No I ater than the el ection to be hel d in February, 2001, the board shal I provide for single-member el ection districts, and menbers of the board shall resi de in and be el ected from si ngl e-menber di stricts as provided in this section. The board shall di vide . 127470. 1the area vocational school district into five el ection di stricts numbered 1 through 5 , whi ch shall constitute the si ngle member districts. At the first el ection in which single menber districts are in effect, board members shall be el ected for all five positions on the board, with menbers el ected to positions 1,3 and 5 el ected for initial terns of two years and members el ected to positions 2 and 4 el ected for initial terms of four years. After that initial el ection, board menbers shall be el ected for a term of four years.
E. Once foll owing each federal decenni al census, the board shall redi strict to ensure that the di stricts remain as equal in popul ation as practicable. The new districts shall go into effect at the first regul ar board el ection thereafter. Candi dates for the new single-menber districts that are schedul ed to be voted on at the el ection shall reside in and be el ected from the appropriate new singl e- nember district. I ncumbent board members whose districts before redistricting were not scheduled to be voted on at the el ection need not reside in the new single-member di stricts corresponding to their position numbers and may serve out their terns. At the second regul ar board el ection hel d after the redistricting, all candi dates for the new single-member di stricts that are schedul ed to be voted on shall reside in and be el ected from the appropriate single-nember district.
F. All el ection districts covered by this section
shall be contiguous, compact and as equal in population as is practicable.
[E.] G. A vacancy occurring on the board shall be filled in the same manner as provided for school board vacanci es in Section 22-5-9 NMSA 1978; provided that if a vacancy occurs in an el ection district where a nonresi dent board member had been serving the vacancy shall be filled with a resident of that district.
[F.] H. A member of the board may be recalled pursuant to the provisions of the Local School Board Member Recall Act, except that a recall el ection may be hel d onl y at the same time as a regul ar school di strict el ection."
