8	policies;						
9	(4) assessment of district performance on the						
10	required state testing;						
11	(5) early childhood development issues;						
12	(6) parental involvement; and						
13	(7) other education issues that come before

15	C. The local school board shall give written						
16	notice to the members of the advisory council of all of its						
17	board meetings.						
18	D. The public school advisory council shall advise						
19	and assist the local school board in expanding parental						
20	participation and involvement in the decision-making process						
21	at the local school board level. Members of the advisory						
22	council shall regularly consult with the local school board on						
23	the effectiveness of educational programs offered by the						
24	district and make recommendations to enhance the benefits of						
25	the programming for the school children."
