BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the following agencies for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the purpose of promoting participation in census 2000 by developing public service announcements, group awareness events and other means of informing New Mexicans of the benefits of responding to and participating in census 2000:
