## I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

- to the eleventh judicial district court one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court facilities in San Juan and McKinley counties and develop plans for new or renovated facilities;
- to the twelfth judicial district court fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court facility in Otero county and develop plans for a new or renovated facility;
- to the thirteenth judicial district court one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court facilities in Valencia and Sandoval counties and develop plans for new or renovated facilities;
- to the fourth judicial district court fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court facility in San Miguel county and develop plans for a new or renovated facility;
- to the sixth judicial district court fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court facility in Grant county and develop plans for a new or renovated facility;
- to the seventh judicial district court
  one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to prepare an architectural study of the district court
  facilities in Sierra, Socorro and Torrance counties and develop plans for new or renovated facilities;
