WHEREAS, there is a need for the legislature to provide
for adequate funding for the acquisition of necessary
technology for distance education delivery; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the legislature to remove
the funding formula disincentives regarding distance learning;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the higher educational institutions

13 transmitted to the chairman of the legislative education study
14 committee and the board of regents at each higher educational
15 institution.
