A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO
MAINTAIN SEPARATE STATISTICS DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN STUDENTS
WHO EARN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA AND STUDENTS WHO EARN A
GRADUATE EQUIVALENCY DEGREE.

WHEREAS, the state department of public education annually prepares and publishes a report on public and private education in the state and distributes the report to the governor and the legislature; and

WHEREAS, many students in this state are dropping out of school and electing to seek a general equivalency diploma rather than a high school diploma; and

WHEREAS, the state department of public education is considering the maintenance of records that would fail to distinguish between students who have earned graduate . 127928.1

equivalency degrees and those who have earned high school diplomas, thus skewing the state dropout rate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public education be required to maintain separate records and statistics distinguishing between students who receive a high school diploma and students who earn a graduate equivalency degree; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public education report its annual statistics distinguishing between students who receive a high school diploma and students who earn a graduate equivalency degree to the governor and the legislature prior to December 1 of each year in accordance with Subsection D of Section 22-2-6 NMSA 1978; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the superintendent of public instruction and the members of the legislative education study committee.
