A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION
DEPARTMENT RESPECT TRADITIONAL RURAL COMMUNITIES, HISTORIC AND
CULTURAL SITES AND INVOLVE LOCAL COMMUNITIES DURING
RECONSTRUCTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 14.

WHEREAS, state highway 14 is a scenic roadway between
Santa Fe and Cedar Crest, attracting significant tourist
dollars to communities along the route; and

WHEREAS, the highway corridor traverses several
traditional communities designated by Santa Fe county; and

WHEREAS, there are many historic sites also along the
route; and

WHEREAS, these scenic, historic, prehistoric and
culturally valued communities and sites may be damaged by
construction of improvements to state highway 14; and

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1 WHEREAS, the United States department of transportation
2 federal highway administration has developed flexibility in
3 highway design that allows for the preservation of historic
4 and scenic value while ensuring safe and efficient highways;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
6 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state
7 highway and transportation department be requested to involve
8 the local communities, neighborhoods and businesses along
9 state highway 14 in the development and adoption of the
10 environmental assessment and final design of the
11 reconstruction of state highway 14; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state highway and
13 transportation department be requested to exercise care and
14 sensitive planning in carrying out the reconstruction of state
15 highway 14; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state highway and
17 transportation department be requested to incorporate
18 flexibility in highway design as set forth by the United
19 States department of transportation federal highway
20 administration in the final design of the reconstruction of
21 state highway 14; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
23 transmitted to the secretary of highway and transportation,
24 members of the Santa Fe board of county commissioners and
25 concerned citizens of Cerrillos.
