15 its recommendations to the legislative finance committee and
16 the legislative council by November 30, 1999; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
18 transmitted to the legislative council, the governor, the
19 secretary of energy, minerals and natural resources, the
20 secretary of environment, the state engineer and the director
21 of the department of game and fish.
