A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE

CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO CHANGE THE DESIGNATION OF THE

YEARS IN WHICH REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE ARE HELD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"A. Each regular session of the legislature shall begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January. Every regular session of the legislature convening during an [odd-numbered] even-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed sixty days, and every regular session of the legislature convening during an [even-numbered] odd-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed thirty days. No special session of the legislature shall exceed thirty days.
