10 A JOINT RESOLUTION  
11 PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 4, SECTION 10 OF THE CONSTITUTION  
12 OF NEW MEXICO TO DECREASE THE PER DIEM AND MILEAGE ALLOWANCE  
13 FOR LEGISLATORS AND PROVIDE FOR LEGISLATIVE COMPENSATION.  
14

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 10  
17 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

18 "Each member of the legislature shall receive:

19 A. per diem [~~at the internal revenue service per~~  
20 ~~diem rate for the city of Santa Fe]~~ at the rate authorized by  
21 law for nonsalaried public officers for each day's attendance  
22 during each session of the legislature and [~~the internal~~  
23 ~~revenue service standard mileage rate]~~ mileage at the rate  
24 authorized by law for each mile traveled in going to and  
25 returning from the seat of government by the usual traveled

1 route, once each session as defined by Article 4, Section 5 of  
2 this constitution;

3 B. per diem expense and mileage at the same rates  
4 as provided in Subsection A of this section for service at  
5 meetings required by legislative committees established by the  
6 legislature to meet in the interim between sessions and other  
7 meetings approved by the legislative council; and

8 [~~C. no other compensation, perquisite or~~  
9 ~~allowance~~]

10 C. compensation no higher than the compensation  
11 authorized by law for elected county commissioners in class A  
12 counties. The legislature by law shall set legislative  
13 compensation. "

14 Section 2. The amendment proposed by this  
15 resolution shall be submitted to the people for their approval  
16 or rejection at the next general election or at any special  
17 election prior to that date which may be called for that  
18 purpose.
