15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. A new section of the Public School Code is
17	enacted to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM
19	A. The department of education shall establish the
20	"alternative education program" in Sandoval county to provide
21	alternative education programs to students in grades eight
22	through twelve to run from July 1, 1999 to June 30, 2003.
23	B. The alternative education program shall provide
24	the following:
25	(1) eighth grade transition programs that

2	(a) after-school programs for eighth
3	grade students failing two or more core classes;
4	(b) eighth grade summer programs for
5	eighth grade students who failed two or more core classes; and
6	(c) transition programs for eighth
7	grade students who do not successfully complete either of the
8	programs described in Subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this
9	paragraph;
10	(2) high school alternative day programs that
11	provi de:
12	(a) six to eight classrooms for high
13	school students that would not succeed on a conventional high
14	school campus;
15	(b) a variety of educational approaches
16	and strategies;
17	(c) opportunities for educational
18	technology; and
19	(d) school-to-work connections;
20	(3) high school accelerated programs for
21	school dropouts that provide:
22	(a) educati onal - technol ogy- based
23	learning programs on-site or from remote locations;
24	(b) opportunities for acceleration and
25	advanced learning; and

3	(4) evening school programs for students who
4	have failed a day school course, seek to accelerate their high
5	school program or choose to take a course for enrichment or
6	for college credit that provides:
7	(a) conventional courses from the Rio
8	Rancho high school program of studies;
9	(b) enrichment courses, including
10	courses in the area of technology and the arts;
11	(c) educational-technology-based
12	learning programs on-site or from remote locations;
13	(d) opportunities for acceleration and
14	advanced learning; and
15	(e) links with community colleges and
16	work force development programs.
17	C. The department of education shall request
18	funding for the alternative education program in its annual
19	agency budget request.
20	D. The department of education shall report to the
21	legislative education study committee on the progress of the
22	alternative education program by November 1, 2002."
23	Section 2. APPROPRIATION Two hundred fifty thousand
24	dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to
25	the state department of public education for expenditure in

work force development programs; and

(c) links with community colleges and

fiscal years 2000 through 2003 for the purpose of funding the operational costs of the alternative education program in Sandoval county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2003 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
