AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIME; CREATING THE CRIME OF THREATENING OR ATTEMPTING TO ASSAULT, KIDNAP OR MURDER A JUDGE OR AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER OF A JUDGE; CREATING THE CRIME OF MALICIOUS SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION OF A JUDGE OR AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER OF A JUDGE; IMPOSING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] THREATENING OR ATTEMPTING TO ASSAULT, KIDNAP OR MURDER A JUDGE OR AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER OF A JUDGE--PENALTY.--

A. No person shall threaten or attempt to assault, kidnap or murder a judge or the immediate family member of a judge with the intent to:

(1) cause actual harm to the judge or the immediate family member of a judge;
