AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT TO PROVIDE FOR BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 5-10-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 297, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"5-10-3. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Local Economic Development Act:

A. "arts and cultural district" means a developed district of public and private uses that is created pursuant to the Arts and Cultural District Act;

B. "broadband telecommunications network facilities" means the electronics, equipment, transmission facilities, fiber-optic cables and any other item directly

1 related to a system capable of transmission of internet
2 protocol or other formatted data at transmission speeds of a
3 minimum of ten megabits per second of download speed and one
4 megabit per second of upload speed, all of which will be owned

7 is owned by the state, a county, a municipality or a qualifying
8 entity that serves the public through preserving, educating and
9 promoting the arts and culture of a particular locale,

12 and organizations, fine arts organizations, studios and media
13 laboratories and live-work housing facilities;

17 means the provision of direct or indirect assistance to a
18 qualifying entity by a local or regional government and

22 infrastructure, including trenching and conduit, for the
23 placement of new broadband telecommunications network

2 to implement a plan or project; the provision of direct loans

6 exceed the revenue that may be derived from the municipal
7 infrastructure gross receipts tax or the county infrastructure
8 gross receipts tax; grants for public works infrastructure

1 of agricultural products, commonly known as farmers' markets;

2 (7) a business that is the developer of a
3 metropolitan redevelopment project;

4 (8) a cultural facility; and

5 (9) a retail business;

6 [~~J~~] K. "regional government" means any combination
7 of municipalities and counties that enter into a joint powers
8 agreement to provide for economic development projects pursuant
9 to a plan adopted by all parties to the joint powers agreement;
10 and

11 [~~K~~] L. "retail business" means a business that is
12 primarily engaged in the sale of goods or commodities at retail
13 and that is located in a municipality with a population,
14 according to the most recent federal decennial census, of:

15 (1) ten thousand or less; or

16 (2) more than ten thousand but less than
17 thirty-five thousand if:

18 (a) the economic development project is
19 not funded or financed with state government revenues; and

20 (b) the business created through the
21 project will not directly compete with an existing business
22 that is: 1) in the municipality; and 2) engaged in the sale of
23 the same or similar goods or commodities at retail."
